The Henderson Bequest Scholarship

- The Ben Henderson Country Student Scholarships were specifically created for rural South Australian students (living approximately 200k from CBD), attending university in Adelaide and living at Lincoln College.
- Applicants must demonstrate financial need and show evidence of academic competency, civic and community potential.
- Ben Henderson was a self made man who believed in “a hand up, not a hand out.”
- This scholarship is an encouragement to those who may very well one day help others in the same way.
- The Entry Scholarship is worth between a quarter to half fees for the residential component. Advance fees and College Club fees are not covered.
- All the rules of the regular scholarships apply – these can be found on our website under Future Residents/Bursaries & Assistance.
- If you wish to be considered for the Henderson Entry Scholarship you will need to complete the information requested below and return it to the Principal by 3 February 2012, 4pm

Application process:

1. Your eligibility will be based on your application to Lincoln College, including your references.
2. In addition, if you do not have a reference from your school principal (or if you are already at University, from the Head of Faculty) you will need one.
3. You must also submit a 500 word essay on one of the following topics: “What community values mean to me” or “How I want to change the world”
4. You must also complete and submit the financial statement (see below), which is a hurdle criterion

We are looking for applicants who have academic potential and who have been active members in their communities (school, town, etc).

The scholarships will be awarded to residents for whom the Committee considers the Henderson Entry Scholarship will make a significant difference, and who in return will make a significant contribution to Lincoln College and to the community at large.
