



Lincoln College Schedule of Fees 2012

(all costs are in Australian dollars)

- Residence of Lincoln College is normally for the full academic year.
- Residents wishing to terminate their residency before the end of their contract should note that they remain liable for their fees until the end of their contract.
- No refunds will apply to residents leaving before the end of their contract date.
- All fees and charges are due in advance.
- Fees and charges include all applicable GST charges. The College reserves the right to increase the fees should the College's GST liability increase.
- Any variations to fee payment arrangements must be made with the Residential Services Manager before the beginning of the year.
- Late payment of fees attracts a surcharge of 0.05% per week equivalent to 26% per annum calculated from the due date.
- The Contingency Bond (Room Holding Deposit \$200AUD plus the Residency Acceptance Bond \$400AUD = \$600AUD), is payable as a security deposit for maintenance of College property and compliance with the Conditions of Admission and the Rules.
- Where all fees and charges are met, the Contingency Bond will be refunded in full except for the fee of \$60 for Life Membership of the Alumni Association.
- Fees may be paid using cheque, Visa card, MasterCard, direct deposit or FORTNIGHTLY direct debit. Direct debit forms are available from College Central.
